Do you know when situations are leadership-ready?

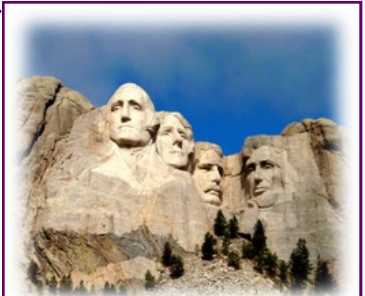
Great leaders choose the best course of action based upon situational variables. Regardless of your personal leadership style, you can be successful if you appropriately discern situational favorableness.

First, you must determine the team's trust in you and their respect for you. Second, you must determine the extent to which responsibilities are clear and structured. Third, you must consider the authority and influence you have on the team.

When you are empowered to lead, when you have a good relation with the team, and when the team knows what is expected of them, the situation is considered favorable for leadership.

In essence, when your style of leadership is sensitive to the situation at hand, your leadership prowess is likely to shine through.
